## Hail Insurance...

Due to the worries of high input cost and high commodity prices, you may want to consider adding hail insurance onto your existing multi-peril policy or to a stand alone policy. The rules state that you can add this coverage onto any acres two hours prior to a hail storm. Please call us if you would like rates or more information about this type of insurance.

## Reporting Your Planted Acres...

When you get your acres planted, please stop in to report them!

- \* We need the number of acres, the legals, crop share and plant dates.
- \* Also, remember, all of the information needs to match the FSA paperwork.
- \* Don't forget your sugar beet and malting barley contracts!
- \* Please be aware of the reporting deadlines and report your info prior to these dates.
- \* Always review your summaries to make sure all your information is correct.

## Replants...

If you think you need to replant your crop, please contact us immediately. The replant provisions state that the replant must be 20 acres or 20% of the unit. To be paid, please keep your seed receipts and any other expenses you have related to replanting.

## Losses...

In order for losses to be paid correctly, please understand all losses must be reported immediately - even if you plan on taking it to harvest.

*Sunflowers - June 15*

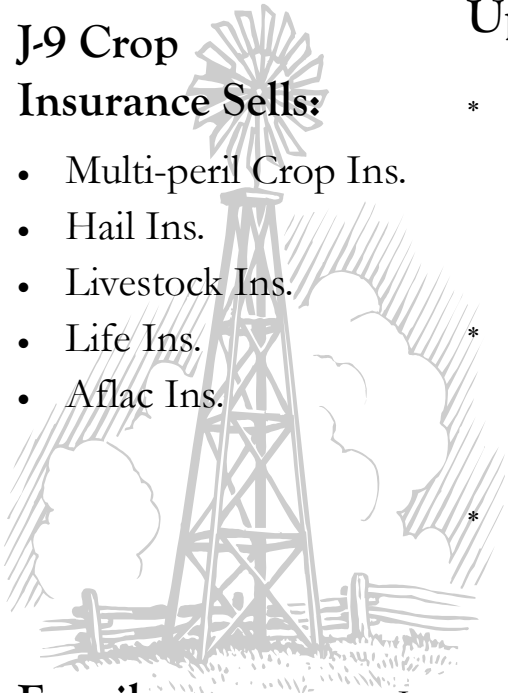
*Sweet Corn - June 15*
